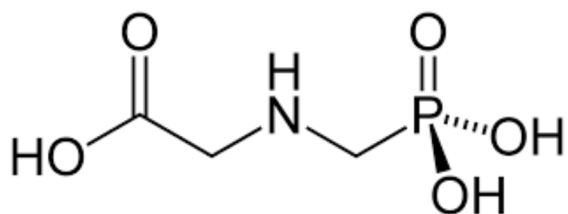


KNOW YOUR CHEMICAL HERBICIDES

GLYPHOSATE

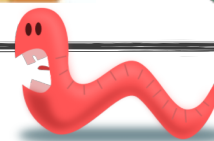


REMEMBER



Chemical herbicides are poisons designed to kill a specific type of plant. Each container of herbicide sold has explicit instructions on its proper use.

EFFECT ON KONA'S SOIL



The soil in Kona act like a sieve and cannot provide any filtering action. As a result there is a greater potential of it entering the ocean and further degrading the soil, including important organic matter

IMPORTANT SAFETY TIPS WHEN HANDLING CHEMICAL HERBICIDES

- *Read & follow instructions herbicide*
- *Always wear protective gear/wear*
- *Do NOT mix more concentrate than specified*
- *Check wind conditions to prevent chemical drift*
- *Ensure no one enters treated area after spraying*
- *Do NOT overspray herbicide*
